

MEMBERSHIP RULES

JUSTICE REMEDEM

Centre For Conflict and Online Dispute Resolution



Definitions

Membership Committee: Duly constituted by the Centre For Conflict and online Dispute Resolution – Justice Remedem.

Member: means an applicant admitted to the council as per the Rules in any of the categories.

Membership

Centre For Conflict and online Dispute Resolution – Justice Remedem has the following categories of membership: Life Member, Member, Associate Member, Institutional Member, Corporate Member and Student Member.

Applicants are admitted to membership as per the Rules of Centre For Conflict and online Dispute Resolution – Justice Remedem, which is in force at the time of making the application and with amendment carried out from time to time in the about discretion of the Counsel.

The assessment of every application of membership is based on the information furnished by the applicant, whose responsibility it is to ensure the details provided are accurate and correct. In the event of this information being found to be incorrect at the time the application was made or later, membership will be withdrawn with immediate effect. Re- instatement of membership will require a new application, and in its absolute discretion of the Executive Committee.

Membership of Centre For Conflict and online Dispute Resolution – Justice Remedem is open to all nationalities-individuals (who are of sound mind and are major), institutions and corporates (with clean records and are not indulging any anti-state activities) and who have unflinching faith in aims and objectives of the society.

The applicant whose membership is accepted and approved by the Organization hereby agrees to abide by these Rules including amendments carried out from time to time, without any written intimation.

The application would be processed and approved by the Membership Committee constituted by the Council of Justice Remedem. The applicant will be duly intimated regarding the admission and the applicant membership subscription and membership shall be effective part payment of its accepts

Members accepted to membership will pay their respective subscription on each financial year basis are liable to pay full year subscription fees irrespective of the month of admission

3.0. Membership Committee

The Membership Committee shall consist of 3 members, nominated from amongst the Founder Members from time to time.

The decision of the Committee with respect to Membership shall be final.

The Membership Committee shall oversee the membership retention, recruitment and engagement activities of the Council.

If a member, through activities in a professional capacity, or through criminal activities in a personal capacity is considered to have brought disrepute to the Organisation, the Membership Committee, in its absolute discretion, may cancel the membership of that individual or organisation until such time that the member can supply information to show that membership may be reinstated.

Rights, Duties and Privileges:

Every member will enjoy all rights and privileges of the Centre for Conflict and online Dispute in accordance with the provisions of Memorandum of Association, Membership Rules and Regulations and Bye – Laws. These rights and privileges are however nontransferable.

Every institutional/Corporate member's shall be entitled to nominate two witness who will be entitled to attend and participate in the and programs, which are organized by Justice Remedem or by its affiliated organizations from time to time subject to terms and conditions of the event and programs.

The Member who is made part of Committees of Justice Remedem or representative of Justice Remedem at any platform will not act in any manner, which damages or is likely to discredit or otherwise adversely affect the reputation of the Centre For Conflict and online Dispute Resolution – Justice Remedem.. No member can enter into financial agreement with third parties on behalf of the Organisation without the express consent of the President/Secretary failing which the member would be personally liable for debts and any legal proceedings thereof.

4.4. The Member is entitled to reflect in his profile that he/she is a Member Centre For Conflict and online Dispute Resolution – Justice Remedem..

4.6. Every Member will have duty to work towards the attainment of the objectives of the Organisation.

4.5. Every Member is duty bound to attend the meetings of the Organisation as may be notified from time to time.

Voting Rights:

All members shall be entitled to participate in the General Body meeting. The Institutional and Corporate members, shall be entitled to nominate one representative for the said meeting and shall have only voting right.

The Associate Member, the Student Member have no voting right in any of the meetings. They however will be free to express their views, for consideration of which should be placed in the general meeting for consideration approved by the Executive Committee.

The Member whose subscription is in arrears will not enjoy voting rights till the satisfaction of the same within the notified dated.

Disclaimers and Limitation of Liability

Membership of the Centre For Conflict and online Dispute Resolution – Justice Remedem. does not create any enforceable rights or obligations directly between Members or against the Organisation.

The Member acknowledges that the Membership Committee of the Centre For Conflict Resolution – Justice Remedem, without incurring any liability to the Member and without prejudice to any other rights or remedies of the Council, take such action as is necessary in the opinion of the Membership Committee to protect the legitimate interests of the Centre For Conflict and online Dispute Resolution – Justice Remedem.

Amendment to Rules

The Centre For Conflict and online Dispute Resolution – Justice Remedem may publish amendments to these Rules from time to time, which will become binding upon the Member upon publication. The Centre For Conflict Resolution – Justice Remedem will make the amended version of these Rules available on the Centre For Conflict and online Dispute Resolution – Justice Remedem website : www.justiceremedem.com

Dispute Resolution

Any dispute with regard to the membership shall be referred to the Governing body of the Centre For Conflict and online Dispute Resolution – Justice Remedem for amicable settlement. To the person or body notified Failing any amicable settlement, for mediation within 15 Working Days of notice from either party calling on the other so to agree, In case the parties fail to agree upon the Mediator, the same may be referred to the President of the Centre For Conflict and online Dispute Resolution – Justice Remedem and his decision shall be final and binding.

General

These Rules are subject to laws of India and the courts at New Delhi will have exclusive jurisdiction to deal with any dispute.

If any provision of these Rules is held to be unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, all other provisions will nevertheless continue in full force and effect.

All notices which are required to be given under these Rules must be in writing and sent, in respect of Centre For Conflict and online Dispute Resolution – Justice Remedem at its principal office and additionally by an email and, with respect of the Member, to the address provided to the Council by the Member by registered post and email. The organisation is not responsible for non-communication or any loss incurred due to change of address of the Member not duly notified to the organisation.

These Rules shall constitute the entire agreement between the Member and the organisation relating to the Membership.
